That was to be expected; but what wasn't expected, was how moving it all was."

With three choreographers each putting their own spin on movement and emotion, the show will undoubtedly appeal to views of all ages. The first choreographer, Susan Rethorst, uses the beauty in everyday life to dictate the dance moves and lets the dancers enter into a dialogue with the piece itself. The second choreographer, John Heginbotham, utilizes the music of American composer Steve Reich to drive the action of the dancer's home as they become the main instrument alongside the Horangee Blut Quartet. The last but not least choreographer, Melanie Rios Glaser, deconstructs and reassembles the life of teenagers by how stereotypes have been formed due to the culture differences around them.
