Featured Red Wines

 **2008 Antinori Guado al Tasso Bolgheri. Tuscany, Italy.**
Here's a "wow" wine on every level, with incredible intensity and supple softness that builds momentum over many long minutes. A sweet cherry note at the core is surrounded by lush layers of tobacco, dark chocolate, and spice, which have evolved gracefully over the years. Wine Enthusiast's #1 Wine of the Year 2013. **Wine Enthusiast Rated: 98 pts. Retail Cost: \$110.**

 **2005 Cellar Vall Llach, Vall Llach. Priorat, Spain.**
The flagship 2005 Vall-Llach is composed of 65% Carinena, 15% Syrah, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 5% Merlot aged for 12 months in new French oak. Opaque purple-colored, it offers up a splendid aromatic array including pain grille, slate, mushroom, espresso, garrigue, blueberry, and black currant. This pedal to the metal Priorat is opulent, full-bodied, and rich. **Wine Advocate Rated: 96+ pts. Retail Cost: \$100.**

 **2010 Clos du Caillou Chateauneuf du Pape Reserve. Rhone, France.**
The virtually perfect 2010 Chateauneuf du Pape Reserve Le Clos du Caillou displays a dense purple color accompanied by a stunning nose of lead pencil shavings, barbecue smoke, black currant jam, raspberries, and blueberries. This stunning wine is full-bodied, exceptionally pure, powerful, and elegant. **The Wine Advocate Rated: 100 pts. Retail Cost: \$205.**

 **2012 Aubert Chardonnay Larry Hyde and Sons Vineyard. Carneros, California.**
The 2012 Chardonnay Larry Hyde bursts from the glass with notes of exotic fruits, wet stones, limes, and white peaches. It has a kinship to a great Corton-Charlemagne. This killer wine is complex and full-bodied with stunning purity, richness, and acidity. **Wine Advocate Rated: 96 pts. Retail Cost: \$135.**

 **2009 Chapoutier Saint Joseph les Granits Blanc. Rhone, France.**
This 100% Marsanne cuvee exhibits an amazing honeyed, orange marmalade character intermixed with notions of crushed rocks, spring flowers, quince, and white currants. It is full-bodied and unctuously textured yet remarkably fresh and vibrant. **Wine Advocate Rated: 98 pts. Retail Cost: \$87.**

 **2012 Cullen Wines Chardonnay Kevin John. Margaret River, Australia.**
The 2012 Kevin John Chardonnay reveals a savory and nutty nose with aromas of crushed cashews, baking bread, yeast extract, and struck match enveloping a core of spiced apples and peaches. Light to medium-bodied, the palate is very tightly knit with a lively acid backbone to support the intense apple and toast flavor layers. **Wine Advocate Rated: 96+ pts. Retail Cost: \$118.**

 **2010 Domaine Serene Pinot Noir Evenstad Reserve. Willamette Valley, Oregon.**
The 2010 Pinot Noir Evenstad Reserve has a very pure, almost unassuming, nonchalant bouquet with pretty red berry fruit complemented by bay leaf and sous-bois aromas. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy red berry fruit, fine salinity, and a gentle build to quite a convincing tea-leaf finish that is very classic in style. Wine Spectator's #3 Wine of the Year 2013. **Wine Spectator Rated: 95 pts. Retail Cost: \$70.**

 **2011 L'Aventure Winery Estate Cuvee. Paso Robles, California.**
Impeccably balanced and light on the palate, the 2011 Estate Cuvee is 48% Syrah, 28% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 24% Petit Verdot. Deep, rich, and layered, with thrilling cassis, blackberry, lead pencil, spice, spring flowers, and smoke, it flows onto the palate with awesome purity, a straight focused profile and sweet tannin that emerge through the mid-palate and finish. **Wine Advocate Rated: 98 pts. Retail Cost: \$85.**

 **2010 Terlato & Chapoutier Syrah de Malakoff. Victoria, Australia.**
Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2010 Syrah de Malakoff gives notes of bacon fat, aged meat, and prunes with a background of figs, warm blackberries, and vanilla, plus forest floor and anise hints. Medium to full-bodied, it offers great structure in the mouth going firm and herbal in the long finish. **Wine Advocate Rated: 97 pts. Retail Cost: \$54.**

Featured White Wines

 **2010 Domaine Bonneau du Martray Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru. Burgundy, France.**
The 2010 Corton-Charlemagne offers an enticing array of marine scents on the nose: cockle shells and estuarine aromas. Give it a couple more minutes and watch those lovely grilled walnut scents flourish and multiply. The palate makes an immediate impression on the entry with that subtle nutty theme continuing, partnered with racy acidity, superb concentration, and a long, energetic finish. **Wine Advocate Rated: 96 pts. Retail Cost: \$151.**

 **2011 Paul Lato Chardonnay Le Souvenir Sierra Madre Vineyard. Santa Barbara, California.**
The 2011 Chardonnay Le Souvenir Sierra Madre Vineyard delivers richness and texture, with gorgeously pure aromas and flavors of baked apple tart, toasted hazelnut, brioche, and crisp minerality. Thrilling on the palate, with a medium to full-bodied profile, awesome detail and delineation, and a seamless finish, it will knock your socks off. **Wine Advocate Rated: 97 pts. Retail Cost: \$73.**

 **2010 Domaine William Fevre Chablis les Preuses. Burgundy, France.**
Fevre's 2010 Chablis Les Preuses accentuates both the sweet-saline savor of scallop and the briny, nutty, oyster liqueur, and seaweed resulting in an experience that taps the imagination and salivary glands. The bittersweet floral perfume further allure, while fresh citrus serves for luscious refreshment. This beauty finishes with superb complexity and clarity. **Wine Advocate Rated: 97 pts. Retail Cost: \$141.**
